**MOTION FOR JUDGMENT AND  
ORDER TO PAY**

17 Pursuant to RCW 6.27.250, Petitioner / Judgment Creditor requests the Court enter, ex  
18 parte, a Judgment on Answer and Order to Pay directing the Garnishee Respondent to pay the  
19 Petitioner / Judgment Creditor through the registry of the Court the funds as outlined on the  
20 Garnishee Respondent's Answer on file herein, in the amount of \$8,267.40 in partial satisfaction  
21 of the Writ of Garnishment with Bank of America on file herein.

23 **FACTS**

24 On July 20, 2021, this Court issued a Writ of Garnishment (Debts Other Than on Earnings)  
25 to Bank of America against Respondent, Michael DeLance. On July 29, 2021, Bank of America

1 submitted their Answer to the Writ on file herein. Bank of America will be garnishing funds in  
2 the amount of \$8,267.40, payable to Petitioner / Judgment Creditor in partial satisfaction of the  
3 Writ.

6 **AUTHORITY**

7 Garnishee Respondent has answered that it is indebted to the Respondents in the non-  
8 exempt amount of \$8,267.40, which is less than the amount owing on the Writ. RCW 6.27.250  
9 permits Petitioner to “apply for the judgment and order to pay ex parte” so long as there is no  
10 unresolved exemption claim and no pending controversion. There is no unresolved exemption  
11 claim and no pending controversion as of the time of this motion. Petitioner / Judgment Creditor  
12 is now entitled to entry of a Judgment on Answer and Order to Pay. A proposed order is submitted  
13 herewith.
