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reflective of the fees and costs incurred from December 10, 2021 through January 31, 2022. To date, the Respondent has not paid the Petitioner anything.

On March 28, 2022, this Court entered an Order Appointing Special Master to effectuate a transfer of stock from the Respondent to the Petitioner. The appointment of the Special Master was necessary due to the Respondent's repeated failure to comply with the terms of the Decree of Dissolution and the subsequent CR2A Agreement which was executed on November 26, 2021. The Order Appointing Special Master specifically states that "all fees and costs charged by the Special Master shall be borne by the Respondent, Michael DeLance." The Order also states that "such fees shall be entered as a judgment in her favor against Respondent and may be entered as an Ex Parte judgment." The order also states that all attorney's fees and costs incurred by the Petitioner as a result of the special master's appointment shall be entered as a Judgment against the Respondent and may be entered as an Ex Parte Judgment.

Since the Court entered the Order Appointing Special Master, the Respondent has unsuccessfully filed four (4) motions relative to the special master's appointment. In two of those motions, the Respondent attempted to vacate that order. The other two motion were filed in an attempt to compel the Petitioner to provide him with the Special Master's contact information and also hold the Petitioner in contempt, though there was no legal basis to do so. These have all been denied and the Petitioner has incurred fees and costs in responding to these baseless motions. On June 2, 2022, the Court ordered the Respondent to pay the Petitioner \$2,500 in attorney's fees and costs, which he has also failed to do.

The Respondent also inappropriately communicated with the shareholders of the company in an attempt to thwart the court-ordered transfer of the stock shares to the Petitioner. The

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Respondent provided the shareholders with false information, which further delayed the transfer, and which increased the costs and fees of both the special master and attorney's fees and costs. The transfer was not completed until September 24, 2022 due to the Respondent's actions.

The Special Master's total fees and costs equal \$9,210.67. Mr. Wurdeman has satisfied the obligations of his appointment and should be formally discharged.

The Petitioner has incurred an additional \$21,833.90 in attorney's fees and costs from February 1, 2022 to September 27, 2022 related to the special masters' appointment.

AUTHORITY

On February 15, 2022, the Court ordered the Respondent to pay \$7,676.50 to the Petitioner. On March 28, 2022, the Court specifically ordered the Respondent to pay all fees and costs associated with the appointment of the Special Master and authorized the Petitioner to obtain an Ex Parte Judgment awarding those fees and costs. On June 2, 2022, the Court ordered the Respondent to pay \$2,500 to the Petitioner. The Petitioner is entitled to a judgment of attorney's fees and costs incurred as a result of the Special Master's appointment.
